## OBJECTIVE

The position of Coaching Coordinator is responsible for coach and player development and improvement to enable all players within the club to maximize their potential.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide guidance regarding player development and program implementation;
- Provide a vision for the club through designing and implementing a Football philosophy across the club consistent with the FFA National Curriculum;
- Improve all players through coach education;
- Promote and facilitate coaches to undertake further formal coaching training/qualifications;
- Increase the pool of accredited coaches and identify coaches for further development;
- Develop and maintain an effective network of communications and act as a mentor and adviser to all team coaches;
- Design and deliver player development programs; and
- Create a positive culture based on equal opportunities for all players to enjoy and improve their football and foster club loyalty.
- Work with the Football Committee to appoint appropriate coaches to all teams;
- Circulate a coach's code of conduct when appointing a coach;
- Train and develop team coaches through the delivery of age appropriate and 'coach the coach' sessions where required;
- Design and regularly update and improve manuals for coaches;
- Monitor team coaches and help them to plan and implement training sessions;
- Arrange for expert and specialist coaches to present to club coaches and to run specialist training clinics;
- Advise and provide resources for the training priorities and structure for each age group and level;
- Organize and implement external skills clinics for players and coaches;
- Design and implement a player evaluation / feedback to guide coaches;
- Report to the club Football Management Committee through the club Football Committee and Subcommittee; and
- Promote the club within the community.
- Assist with activities and events associated to SUFC – park duty, presentation day, coaches and managers BBQ, muster day.

## ACCOUNTABILITY

- Reports to the President of Football.
- The Coaching Coordinator must seek approval from the Football Committee prior to committing the Club to any financial expenditure or action.
- The Coaching Coordinator is a member of the Football Committee and as such is required to attend Football Committee meetings and assist with ground duty and other club activities.

The estimated time commitment required as the Coaching Coordinator is around 4 - 6 hours per week throughout the pre-season and season.

## **PREFERRED SKILLS**

- Possess coaching qualifications as per FFA Community Pathway, Senior License (preferred);
- Demonstrated knowledge of the FFA National Curriculum;
- An understanding of player and coach pathways as per FFA curriculum; and
- An understanding of any specific football governing body requirements

## **Coach Development**

- Design and implement a coach development plan consistent with FFA National Curriculum principles;
- Facilitating licensing courses and organizing workshops and informally through feedback, observation and mentoring;
- Be available to assist coaches with training sessions on request;
- Assist Grassroots coaches where required; and
- Implement through the coaches a consistent playing style and football philosophy across the club to be reflected in training and match play.

## **Player Development**

- Design and implement a player development plan;
- Design player development programs consistent with FFA National Curriculum principles;
- Foster an attitude of fair play and enjoyment of football amongst all players;
- Organize and implement football training camps and clinics including those offering specialist skill development; and
- Focus on technical skill development (e.g. through camps and clinics), especially through juniors, as well as cohesive team play

The Coaching Coordinator is appointed by the Football Committee (and approved by the Management Committee) for a term of one (1) season.
