

# Consumption & Sale of Alcohol

This policy is in place to ensure that Springwood United Football Club (SUFC) is compliant with Clauses 26 & 27 of The Handbook for use of sporting grounds in the Blue Mountains enforced by Blue Mountains City Council (BMCC).

## 26. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

The consumption of alcohol within sporting ovals is **only permitted** with written permission of Council.

## 27. SALE OF ALCOHOL

The sale of alcohol without a license is prohibited. Application to sell alcohol must be lodged for permission, accompanied by written consent and approval from the Police and Liquor Licensing Court of NSW.

It is the policy of SUFC that no alcohol is to be consumed on Field 1, 2, 3 (including SSG fields) or any surrounding areas within Summerhayes Park during any scheduled Junior Soccer or Netball game(s) in play.

During times of scheduled Senior games and when Junior Soccer or Netball game(s) are not in play at Summerhayes Park, Alcohol may be consumed in the following areas:

- The Grandstand of Field 1
- The Netball Courts (providing no scheduled Netball games are in play)
- 10 metres from the Sideline of Field 2 & 3

Any individual(s) member(s) of SUFC found in breach of this policy will be subject to disciplinary action by the SUFC Board. In addition any individual(s) member(s) of SUFC found in breach of this policy will incur the following penalties under the NDSFA By-Laws.

FIRST OFFENCE = Minimum \$300 fine plus four weeks suspension to the team, manager, coach or player, if involved and found guilty of the offence.

SECOND OFFENCE = Minimum \$600 fine, plus ten weeks suspension to the team, manager, coach or player, if involved and found guilty of the offence.

THIRD OFFENCE = Minimum \$1000 fine plus minimum twelve months suspension to the team manager, coach or player, if involved and found guilty of the offence.

Under NDSFA By-Laws Signs provided by the Association to clubs regarding the consuming of alcohol are to be erected by the club in the following areas – canteen, dressing rooms and adjacent to playing fields.
