Step 1 - Register as a Coach or Manager for **FREE** at www.playfootball.com.au

Step 2 - Note your **FFA Number** to provide to the club.

Step 3 - Complete a **Working With Children** check. **FREE** at www.thekidsguardian.nsw.gov.au

Step 4 – Forward PDF copy of WWC Clearance Letter to childprotection@springwoodunited.com.au

Step 5 - Send '2020 Coaches & Manager EOI' form to coaching@springwoodunited.com.au

Step 6 – Check [NFA Website](#) for **Coaching Development Courses** that you may require.

Step 7 – Encourage players to register ASAP and take advantage of the Active [Kids \\$100 Rebate](#)



Important Information

- All Grass Roots (U5 – U10's) & Division 1 coaches **MUST** have age appropriate FFA Coaching qualifications prior to team nominations.
 - All coaching applications are subject to review by the Football Committee.
- Appointment of coaches is subject to Working With Children Clearance (WWCC) from the office of the Children's Guardian, and other qualifications and experience based on criteria in line with governing body regulations and SUFC Constitution and Bylaws.



How to find a Coaching Course in 2020

Step 1 – Go to www.playfootball.com.au (Ensure you are Registered as a Coach first)

Step 2 – Click on the “Coach” tab and select the drop down menu “Find A Course”

Step 3 – Select a course from the drop down menu, then click on ‘Next 6 months’ and for ‘NSW’
